DigiPlus Interactive Corp. (DigiPlus), operator of digital entertainment platforms BingoPlus, ArenaPlus, and GameZone, recorded a net income of Php8.4 billion for the first six months of the year, a 61 percent increase from the same period in 2024.

The company's performance reflects continued growth in its retail games segment, as well as contributions from new product offerings and operational efficiencies.

Total revenues rose 47 percent to Php47.78 billion from Php32.56 billion in the same period last year, supported by increased business activity and the rollout of new games and licenses approved by PAGCOR. EBITDA for the first half reached Php9.09 billion, up 65 percent from

Php5.51 billion a year ago. In the first half of 2025, DigiPlus remitted Php18.4 billion in government taxes and regulatory fees.

For the second quarter alone, net income was Php4.20 billion, representing a 30 percent year-on- year increase. Revenues reached Php24.71 billion, up 31 percent, while EBITDA rose 32 percent to Php4.50 billion. These figures were driven by new game offerings across DigiPlus' platforms.
